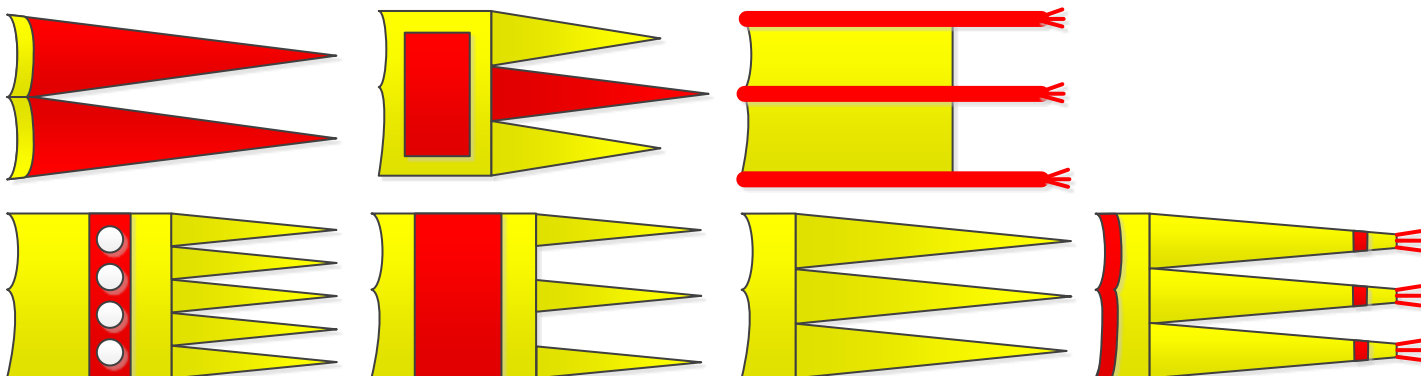


Regia Anglorum Authenticity Guide 2016

Pennons

(Encouraged – All Periods)

It is encouraged that warriors attach a pennon to their two-handed spears. Pennons are commonly depicted in period art and referenced frequently in literature.



Pennons must have a width of between 5 – 7” and a length of 10 – 14”. Most importantly they must be at least twice as long as they are wide. They should be predominantly of one colour and may be decorated in a simple design such as a cross. Please avoid zoomorphic or other complicated designs.

A single thickness of linen is recommended and small amounts of silk can be used as decoration.

Banner Designs

Banners tend to be slightly larger and carried by a standard bearer, a highly honoured and sought after position. Even though, they remain simple, in reality being little more than a larger version of a pennon.

Large warrior entourages should ideally include a banner carried by a warrior in RICH kit. Again please keep banner designs simple, avoiding zoomorphic designs.
